


FETTO Custom — Great Wide Distortion

Owner's Manual (Serial #170-)

Thanks for choosing **FETTO Custom**. Please read this document to get the best use and joy of this Great Wide overdrive/distortion effect.



* The push switch in **FETTO Custom** is not as stiff as the ones you might be used to. If you're a hippie who like to play barefoot this can be a good thing.

** The screen print/layout for **FETTO Custom** could vary with serial number.

FETTO Custom tips & tricks:

It could take some time to get a grip about all possibilities in this pedal. We encourage you to try several different combinations of the outboard control settings as each will impart its own unique character on your tone. Also try to adjust the volume control of your guitar and you will see how flexible, responsive and *real* **FETTO Custom** is.

Every pedal is 100% handmade, tested and carefully adjusted by the original designer in Sweden. If you happen to remove the bottom plate and find a few internal controls—remember the inside parts are *not* meant to be adjusted by the user, because of functional/warranty reasons. - Do not start with the "Treble" control set at max as this might be very bright for some rigs/occasions.
- Even though the power consumption is low (2-3 mA) the battery needs to be replaced when the LED gets weak or if the tone changes in a negative way. To change the battery, unscrew the four screws on the bottom plate, bring out the 9 volt battery (6LR61) and replace it. Then attach the bottom plate with the four screws. Never use **FETTO Custom** without the bottom plate!
- If you play loud, always use ear protection. It's easy to forget when you hear good sounds, but be careful!
- Unplug the OUT cord when not using the pedal—if powered by a battery—to save the battery (and environment).
- Even though The Sound is important, do not forget The Music!
